



RÉÉDUCA INNOV' 2025 REGULATIONS

For Rééduca exhibitors

ARTICLE 1 - RÉÉDUCA INNOV'

In conjunction with Rééduca, to be held **from 9th to 11th October 2025** at Paris Expo Porte de Versailles, RX France, a simplified joint stock company under French law (SAS) with capital of €90,000,000, whose registered office is located at 52 quai de Dion Bouton 92800 Puteaux, registered with the Register of Commerce of Nanterre under no. RCS 410 219 364, is organising the Rééduca Innov' competition to award the most outstanding advances in the field of rehabilitation and physiotherapy presented at the event.

Participants are responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in taking part in this competition, even in the event of postponement, modification or cancellation.

ARTICLE 2 – ENTRANTS

Only Rééduca exhibitors are authorised to submit projects to the Rééduca Innov'2025 competition. Co-exhibitors and retailers may not enter the competition.

ARTICLE 3 – NOMENCLATURE

Projects submitted for the competition must correspond to the Rééduca nomenclature (**see annex**). In their entry, participants must specify the main field of application for which they are competing (open field). The jury is free to reassign the project submitted by the participant to a field of application it considers more relevant.

ARTICLE 4 – ENTRY PROCESS

Registration must be completed by **15th September 2025** at the latest, using a form that can be downloaded directly from the Rééduca Exhibitor Portal.

To be considered for entry, participants must:

- Not have won or been nominated in 2024 with the project they are submitting for 2025,
- Have read and accepted the general regulations for Rééduca Innov'2025,
- Have completed and returned the entry form available in the Exhibitor Portal, typed on a computer only, and accompanied by a high-resolution photo of the product or service ,
- An article substantiating the scientific nature (IMRAD) of the product or service, or any other scientific article substantiating its therapeutic or technical effectiveness or an improvement in the practitioner's practice.

Participants whose entries are shortlisted must also:

- Be available on the **morning of Thursday 9th October 2025** to pitch their innovation(s) to the jury.

Each exhibitor may submit a **maximum of 2 entries**.

Participation in the competition implies irrevocable and unconditional acceptance of these regulations.

ARTICLE 5 – COMPETITION CALENDAR

- **June 2025:** entry pack goes online in the exhibitor portal,
- **15th September 2025:** deadline for returning completed entries,
- **From 20th October 2025:** pre-selection of entries (the entries considered the most convincing based on the criteria pre-established by the jury will be shortlisted) and announcement of the shortlisted participants,
- **9th October 2025, morning:** 3 to 5-minute pitch by each shortlisted participant to jury members in the “Multidisciplinary Conversations” room, followed by a 3-minute Q&A. Visitors will be able to attend participants’ pitches, but will have no say in the judging,
- **9th October 2025 end of day:** awards ceremony and cocktail party organised by Rééduca in Conference Area (health conditions permitting).

ARTICLE 6 – PRIZES

Shortlisted participants will receive:

- An “award nominee” banner to insert in their email signature,
- An “award nominee” sign on their stand **on Thursday 9th October 2025**,
- A presentation at the Rééduca Innov' 2025 awards ceremony before the winners are announced,
- Health conditions permitting, presentation and visibility of their product/service in Virtual Reality format in a dedicated area at the entrance to the show.

A trophy will be awarded to the winners who will also receive (in addition to the promotion offered to the nominees):

- A “winner” banner to insert in their email signature,
- Promotion on the Rééduca Innov' 2025 page of the Rééduca website and on social media,
- Mention in the newsletter issued **on the evening of Thursday 9th October 2025**,
- A “winner” sign on their stand **starting on Friday 10th October 2025**,
- An interview filmed on **Friday 10th October 2025** and broadcast on the show’s website and social media.

ARTICLE 7 – TRUTHFUL INFORMATION / ENTRY CONDITIONS

Entrants undertake to submit information that is truthful and accurate and in particular to avoid any omissions or imprecisions that could lead to an unjustified decision.

If an entrant infringes this rule, the jury reserves the right to revoke a prize that has already been awarded or withdraw the project from the competition. In this case the entrant will not be able to appeal the decision.

Entrants may only submit projects, products, solutions or systems of their own manufacture or design in which they are involved and for which they hold all the rights and authorisations necessary for their submission in the competition and their use by the organiser as provided for in these rules.

Entrants represent to the organiser that the projects, products, solutions or systems they submit do not infringe the rights of third parties.

Entrants accept full liability for their projects, products, solutions or systems with respect to third parties; the organiser shall not in any way be held liable. If any claim is made against the organiser by a third party due to an entrant's actions or products, solutions or systems, the entrant shall indemnify the organiser for all costs reasonably incurred by the organiser for its defence and any sentences handed down.

ARTICLE 8 – JURY

The competition jury is made up of 7 members. Each member of the jury undertakes not to send copies of the entries to any person whatsoever, and not to divulge any information about the jury's choice before the official presentation of the Rééduca Innov' 2025 awards.

If a jury member's organisation or company is competing, they will not be able to take part in judging their company's or organisation's entry.

The jury's decisions regarding the awarding of prizes are final and without appeal, and its deliberations are confidential. The jury is not required to give reasons for its decisions.

ARTICLE 9 – RESULTS

The results will be announced on **Thursday 9th October 2025** at the Rééduca Innov' 2025 awards ceremony, so that each winner can refer to them during Rééduca and disseminate them to the media. The awards ceremony will be open to visitors.

ARTICLE 10 – TERMS OF USE FOR INFORMATION

The names and descriptions of projects, products or services admitted to the competition may be the subject of special communication with the press and professionals before and during Rééduca.

Any commercial or advertising reference to a prize received for the Rééduca Innov'2025 competition must specify the exact title of the prize, the year it was awarded and the Rééduca Innov'2025 logo.

ARTICLE 11 – ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS

Entering the competition entails full acceptance of all clauses herein, without any entitlement to challenge the terms or the results of the competition.

ARTICLE 12 – INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Participants represent to the organiser that they own or have obtained from the owners of the intellectual property rights to the goods/creations/brands they submit to the competition and, more generally, to all the materials they submit to the organiser (video, visuals, text, etc.), all the rights and/or authorisations required for submission and the intended uses of said materials. The organiser shall not be liable in any way in this area.

Entrants authorise the organiser to publish their full name, full contact details of their company and the description of the projects, products, solutions or systems as part of Rééduca Innov'2025 and/or Rééduca marketing and communication campaigns; such use shall not give rise to any right or remuneration of any nature.

Participants authorise the organiser and its service providers to reproduce, depict and adapt the visuals they provide, free of charge, as part of the competition, by any means and on any medium, so that the organiser can carry out the planned activity (virtual reality broadcast at the show).

Participants authorise the organiser to photograph their projects, products, solutions or systems free of charge and to reproduce and depict, free of charge and on any territory, the projects, products, solutions or systems they present, in Rééduca Innov'2025 and/or Rééduca communication tools (Internet, visitor guide, visitor map, promotional videos, etc.) and, more generally, in all media used to promote Rééduca Innov'2025 and/or Rééduca (photographs of the awards and/or the event to be published in the press or on the Internet, television programmes produced at/during the awards and/or Rééduca, without this list being exhaustive). Entrants represent to the organiser that they have obtained from the intellectual property right holders all necessary rights and/or authorisations for the aforementioned uses concerning the products, solutions or systems they enter.

All the above authorisations and assurances are granted for any territory and for the life of the rights concerned.

ARTICLE 13 – CHANGE TO OR CANCELLATION OF RÉÉDUCA INNOV' 2025

The organiser reserves the right to change the competition (including the prizes for the shortlisted participants and winners), particularly in the event of cancellation of the trade show or restrictions preventing the performance of part of the competition, without incurring any liability.

The participant undertakes not to hold this against the organiser.

Postponement of the trade show shall have no impact on the competition (apart from any adjustments to the dates necessitated by the postponement).

The entrant assumes all risks related to the possible non-fulfilment and/or postponement of Rééduca Innov' 2025, and in particular the exclusive responsibility for costs incurred in anticipation of Rééduca Innov' 2025.

ARTICLE 14 – AMENDMENT TO THESE REGULATIONS / SEVERABILITY

The organiser reserves the right to decide on any cases not covered by these regulations and add new provisions whenever it deems necessary for the successful organisation of Rééduca Innov' 2025.

If any provision of these rules should, for any reason whatsoever, be invalid in whole or in part, the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected. In such a case, the organiser undertakes to arrange in good faith for a provision to be made which, as far as possible, has an equivalent effect.

ARTICLE 15 – DISPUTES / STATUTES OF LIMITATION

In the event of a dispute, regardless of the object, entrants undertake to send a claim to the organiser by registered letter, with acknowledgement of receipt, before initiating any other proceeding. Any action initiated within fifteen (15) days following receipt of said registered letter shall be inadmissible.

In accordance with Article 2254 of the French Civil Code, the parties agree to set a limit of one (1) year for rights and legal action concerning the liability of the organiser due to its own actions, those of an employee



or a third party, regardless of the cause thereof. This period shall begin from the expiry of the fifteen (15) day timeframe stipulated above.

RELATIONS BETWEEN COMPETITION PARTICIPANTS AND THE ORGANISER SHALL BE FULLY AND EXCLUSIVELY GOVERNED BY FRENCH LAW.

IN THE EVENT OF A DISPUTE, THE COURT OF COMMERCE OF NANTERRE SHALL HAVE SOLE
